

Rebate & Incentives Quick Facts

Federal

Residential

- 30% federal tax credit (\$2000 maximum)

Commercial

- 30% Investment tax credit
- 5 yr. Accelerated Capital Depreciation

State

The California Solar Initiative Offers:

- For PV system less than 100kW
 - \$2.50 per installed watt of system purchase price for residential
 - \$3.25 per installed watt of system purchase price for government & non-profit entities.
- For PV system greater than 100kW
 - Monthly payment determined recorded on kilowatt hours of power generated from system over a 5 year period.
 - Different incentive rate for commercial entities and for government or non-profit entities.
- Funds for solar installations for existing and new low-income and affordable housing.

The Connecticut Solar Initiative Offers:

- \$5 per watt up to \$25,000 per residence (5kW)
- Funds new low-income housing in the future
- Local option for Property tax is available

The New Jersey Solar Initiative Offers:

- <10kW: \$3 per watt
- 10kW~ 40kW: \$2.75 per watt
- 40kW~ 100kW: \$2.50 per watt
- State Sales tax waived for solar power system.
- Benefit from S-RECs (Solar Renewable Energy Certificate) if participate in the program

The New York Solar Initiative Offers:

- \$4 per Standard Test Conditions watt up to 50kW
- 60% of the total install cost
- 25% tax credit for residential solar installation (\$5000 maximum)
- Sales tax waived in some jurisdictions
